

# Medical Camps - WMD

## Project Overview

WMD conducts medical camps and mobile health interventions in underserved, remote, and disaster-affected areas across Pakistan where access to healthcare is limited due to poverty, distance, emergencies, or natural disasters.

These medical camps are designed to provide immediate, on-ground healthcare services, especially in situations where delays in treatment can result in severe illness or loss of life.

---

## Step 1: Area Identification & Needs Assessment

Before deploying any medical camp, WMD:

identifies **high-need areas** with limited or no access to healthcare, prioritizes regions affected by:

- poverty and unaffordability
- remote geography
- emergencies (floods, earthquakes, disease outbreaks)

conducts field surveys and data collection to assess:

- common illnesses
- emergency medical needs
- age groups most affected

This ensures that each medical camp is need-based and targeted, not generic.

---

## Step 2: Medical & Logistical Preparation

Based on survey findings, WMD prepares a customized medical response, including:

- deployment of relevant specialists and doctors
- procurement of essential medicines
- setup of mobile clinics and remote laboratories

Availability of:

- rapid blood testing kits
- portable diagnostic equipment

- emergency medical supplies
- inclusion of paramedical staff and trained volunteers
- arrangement of vehicles capable of functioning as mobile clinics

This setup allows WMD to deliver primary healthcare, diagnostics, and emergency response on-site.

---

### **Step 3: On-Ground Medical Camps**

Once deployed, WMD medical teams provide:

- free OPD consultations
- basic diagnostic tests (including blood tests where required)
- immediate treatment and medication
- maternal, child, and general healthcare support

For patients with complex or critical conditions, WMD:

- refers them to nearby hospitals or advanced medical facilities
  - covers transportation and treatment costs through WMD's Medical Fund

---

### **Free Medical & Dental Camp - Mansehra**

**Location:** Oghi, Mansehra

**Date:** 22 September 2024

**Collaboration:** PPWO AMC Team

WMD organized a combined medical and dental camp in collaboration with the PPWO AMC Team to provide free healthcare services to the community. The camp offered OPD consultations, general medical checkups, dental examinations, and on-spot medicines.

Impact: 500+ patients treated and provided medicines free of cost.

## **Flood Emergency Medical Camp – Buner (KP)**

**Location:** Balo Khan, Buner

**Date:** 24–25 August 2025

Following flood damage in Buner, WMD deployed mobile medical teams to affected areas. Free OPD services, on-site treatment, and essential medicines were provided. Critical patients were referred to nearby hospitals with transportation and treatment costs covered through WMD's medical fund.

---

## **Flood Emergency Medical Camp – Sindh**

**Location:** Gambat, Sindh

**Date:** 29–30 October 2022

WMD conducted a medical camp in flood-affected Gambat to address post-flood health issues. Services included OPD consultations, treatment of waterborne diseases, distribution of medicines, ORS, and multivitamins. Emergency referrals were supported financially by WMD.

---

## **Flood Emergency Medical Camp – Balochistan (Phase II)**

**Locations:** Usta Muhammad, Dera Murad Jamali

**Date:** 25–30 September 2022

WMD extended flood response operations to central Balochistan through mobile medical camps. Services included OPD care, basic blood tests using portable kits, medicine distribution, ORS, and nutritional support, with a focus on children and elderly patients.

---

## **Flood Emergency Medical Camp – Balochistan (Phase I)**

**Locations:** Jaffarabad, Dera Allah Yar

**Date:** 29–31 August 2022

During the 2022 floods, WMD deployed emergency medical teams to severely affected districts of Balochistan. Free medical consultations, treatment of flood-related illnesses, distribution of medicines, ORS, and multivitamins were provided. Patients requiring advanced care were referred with transport and treatment support.

---

## **Blood Donation Camp & Awareness Seminar**

**Location:** Bahria Town Phase 7

**Date:** 21 November 2021

**Collaboration:** P First Solutions Blood Bank

WMD organized a blood donation camp and awareness seminar to support emergency medical needs. The drive collected blood from community volunteers under medical supervision.

Impact: 50+ blood bags collected, preserved, and utilized for emergency cases, surgeries, and thalassemia patients.
